In 1976 the Mint 400 had two special courses, one for cars and trucks and one course for motorcycles. Walt managed the car/truck course and I managed the motorcycle course.

I thank The Martelli Brothers for giving me the opportunity to promote the event, along with Polaris and BFG. My goal for the Mint 400 is to take it to the next level; I want to make this race greater than the Mint hotel's expectations could have ever been and greater than your expectations of what Best In The Desert can do. This is not only going to be "**The Great American Off-Road Race**" that we have billed it, but mark my words, it is going to be "The G-R-E-A-T American Off-Road Race" that will knock your socks off!

What made the Mint 400 so special? Well, for one, tech inspection was held in Las Vegas on a stretch of downtown that was in its own right a very spectacular piece of real estate in the '60's, 70's and 80's. The Mint 400 was backed by the Mint 400 Hotel Casino and attracted people from all over the world, which included movie stars, the best off-road racers in the day, and people that weren't so skilled, including motorhomes and chopper motorcycles and anything else people could put an engine in. POLARIS RZR MINT 400 presented by BFGoodrich Tires

- 1) **HOTELS:** The **Golden Nugget** is the Host Hotel for **Race Registration** and the **Drivers Meeting**. You can refer to the hotel list on www.bitd.com; for a complete list of hotels that are close to Fremont Street, Downtown Las Vegas and the Primm area.
- 2) **DRAW DATE:** We will Draw for Start Positions on **Wednesday, February 15th** for ALL race vehicles. Rear starts are by first request and post-mark! The line-up for Trick Trucks and Class 1500 for the Time Trials is also determined by this same draw for start positions on the 15th! Get your entries in now to be in the **Souvenir Event Program**, the deadline is February 10th, the program goes to print before the draw!
- 3) **TIME TRIALS:** The time trials is on Thursday, March 2nd for **Trick Trucks** and **Class 1500**. Time Trial event is **NOT mandatory**; if you do not participate in the Time Trials you will be placed by your draw position after the people that did participate.
- 4) **METHOD RACE WHEELS TIME TRIAL AWARD – Method Race Wheels** will once again sponsor the Time Trial award. The Fastest Qualifier will walk away with **\$5000 cash**, that's right, **\$5000 in Cash!** Thank you to **Method Race Wheels** for sponsoring this very prestigious award!
- 5) **PARTY's:** The Event will start out with a parade down Las Vegas Blvd and Kick-Off Party on Wednesday, March 1st. On Thursday, March 2nd, there will be a Meet & Greet on Fremont Street followed up by the Welcome Party, Pit Crew Challenge and the Ms. Mint Crowning. The specific race schedule will be given to you in the Final Information Packet, and check out the Special Event Schedule on **themint400.com** site!
- 6) **CONTINGENCY & TECH:** Registration and the Drivers Meeting will be at the **Golden Nugget** at the beginning of Fremont Street. Contingency & Tech will be on the world famous Fremont Street East and will be an event aside from the race, a contingency like no other!
- 6) **PITS:** There will be **three (3) pits**; the Main Pit Start/Finish, Pit A, Pit B, for all classes. The Main Pit (Start / Finish) area is level and designed for big motorhomes and overnight camping is allowed, you can also overnight camp at Pit A. Main Pit areas, at Primm, have limited parking and pit pass access only. All UTV's will be pitting together at the Main Pit. **Main Pit parking size will be 30' x 75' for each pit, one pit per entry.**
- 7) **RACE INFO:** There will be one large pit area at Primm for everyone; the format will be running two separate races:
 - 1) **1st Race** – 6:00 am – specific classes, 2-Lap and 3-Lap Classes.
 - 2) **2nd Race** – 12 noon (approximately) – larger race vehicles, 3-Lap ClassesRace schedule and race details will be available Feb. 15, in the Final Information Packet.
- 8) **NO PRE-RUN:** There **WILL NOT** be a **PRE-FUN RUN**, due to the desert tortoise habitat.
- 9) **TV/WEB COVERAGE:** MadMedia will be producing another great show on this years Mint 400, and Race-Dezert.com will be covering the event LIVE. Visit **themint400.com** and **facebook.com/themint400** for all the current information on this coverage!
- 10) **TRACKING & SCORING:** All Car, Truck and UTV entry's must have the RacingTrax Satellite Tracking System. The order form is on **RacingTrax.com** **All race vehicles** must have a TRANSPONDER, the transponder is used for scoring (not tracking) and are \$100, available from BITD.
- 11) **SPECTATING:** There will be four (4) BLM approved spectator areas on BLM land, they will have easy access on paved roads but space is limited. A large spectating area will be on private property at Primm. Contact **themint400.com** for Spectating details and to order your tickets.
- 12) The **Mint 400** will be a VERY FRIENDLY SPECTATOR EVENT. Mad Media's goal is to make this a fun event for teams and spectators. Spectators will need special passes for the designated spectator areas and parking is limited. Race teams are not allowed in the spectator areas.
- 13) The **7th Annual 4-Wheel Parts Mint 400 Vehicle Parade** presented by **Odyssey Battery** will once again send hundreds of racers down the world famous Las Vegas Strip on Wednesday, March 1st!
