#### **Best In The Desert Racers:**

Welcome to the **2021 All Terrain Concepts UTV Legends Championship**, *"The Race of Champions"*. This information packet is very important to you, your team, your support crew, and all others who will be joining you. Please read it all the way through. Enclosed you will find a



schedule of events, a vicinity map of the Tropicana Laughlin Hotel & Casino where Tech & Registration will be held, your vehicle race number and Class Entry can be verified online on our posted entry sheet. This Final Information Packet and the Course Map can be found online on our website as we make the transition to a paperless entry process. You may print as many copies of this letter out as you please and if you would like to request a paper packet, please reach out to our Office and we would be glad to send you one.

\*\*COVID-19 MANDATES- It is EXTREMELY IMPORTANT that "WE ALL" follow the rules listed. BITD Signage will be posted at all BITD UTVLC indoor events, per the NV Governor's most recent mandate the use of face masks will be required at all times during indoor UTVLC events. We are privileged to be welcomed guests of the *Town of Laughlin, Clark County & the BLM*, and we want to be welcomed back next year, so think about what you are doing at all times, and don't ruin it for everyone by doing something dumb!

# **GENERAL INFO**

#### \*\*TIME TRIALS\*

Thursday September, 9th, 2021

The TIME TRIALS is for select classes only, the UTV Pro Turbo & Pro Open UTV Classes. The Time Trials starting order will be based on Random Drawing. All entries in the Time Trials will then start the race based on the order in which they qualified in the Time Trials.

#### TIME TRIALS FOR START POSITIONS IS NOT A MANDATORY EVENT!!!

\*\*\*SPECIAL NOTE – Time Trials Registration will be on Thursday, September 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021 from 8:00 AM to 12:00 PM at the Tropicana Laughlin Coronado Room. This will be your only opportunity to register for the Time Trials; you will receive your special Time Trial arm-band, decal and directions to the off-load area. A detailed Time Trial instruction sheet is enclosed in this packet. While you may register at TT, you are required to come through a full tech-inspection at the Tropicana Laughlin Mojave Parking lot on Friday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

# \*\*REGISTRATION-EVENT EXPO-TECH INSPECTION \*\*

Friday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM

## FIRST - Check in at registration in the Tropicana Laughlin in the Coronado Room at 2121 S Casino Dr, Laughlin, NV 89029

At least one arm-banded person listed on your official **UTVLC** entry form must go through Driver registration to be able to tech your vehicle, however, ALL people listed on the entry form must check-in at registration as soon as they arrive to receive their armbands. The balance of your fees must be paid by the first person taking the packet and before you can go through tech. **YOU WIL NOT receive your packet without making final payment, NO Exceptions and bring CASH or CC ONLY!** (BITD ACCEPTS, AMX, VISA, DISCOVER & MASTERCARD). \*\*\* Please come during your allotted times. \*\*\*

#### SECOND – Stop at the Contingency Table set up at the Registration Room

Contingency is designed so that you as a racer, have the opportunity to **earn products**, **credits**, **or even cash money** with our **Contingency Sponsors**, just by using sponsors products or rocking a decal! The stipulations and Contingency form can be found on our website, or our Contingency Coordinator will be onsite with forms and if needed decals! Don't miss out! SPECIAL NOTE: **BITD contingency inspectors will be checking very closely** to make sure the contingency sponsor's products are being used by you!! Please don't say you are using a product if you are not!

# THIRD – <u>Go to the Racing Trax Table set-up inside the Registration room to pick up your tracking unit.</u>

Racing Trax will be mandatory for all BITD races in 2021. Racing Trax is a satellite-based tracking system designed for racer safety! A few items it includes is "push to pass", "Satellite Wi-Fi texting", most importantly the ability for BITD to verify that racers follow the race course, "IT IS NOT USED TO SCORE THE RACE".

## FOURTH - Event Expo, and Technical Inspection - 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM at the Tropicana Laughlin in the Mojave Parking Lot

At least one (1) of the entrants listed on the official **BITD UTV Legends Championship** entry form, with **BITD** Official armband, must be with the race vehicle through Technical Inspection., from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM in the Mojave Parking lot in the Tropicana Laughlin Hotel & Casino. (See Vicinity Map).

## FIFTH – Attend the Mandatory meeting and Racer Appreciation Happy Hour at the Theater Pavilion in the Tropicana Laughlin

DRIVERS MEETINGS ARE BACK! This is a **mandatory meeting** for all teams. At the end of the Drivers Meeting, we pull **25 random names & vehicle numbers**, there must be at least one racer from your team either in person or that is watching our live video. There will be a one-hour (1-hour) time penalty issued to your team if one person, on the random list has not confirmed attendance.



# **Special Notes and Rules!**

- 1. Anyone in the pits will need to have a Pit Pass.
- 2. There will not be a testing or jetting area. Come prepared to race!
- 3. Do not ride any Motorcycle, Quad or UTV in the area of the race course.
- 4. NO riding ATV's or Pit Motorcycles in the area of the pits. NO riding of bicycles in the pit area.
- 5. Clean up your pit area before you leave. We provide Trash Dumpsters, **PLEASE USE THEM!**
- 6. **Hot-Pit** you **may** pit at the Hot-Pit only, **see diagram enclosed in this FIP**. Vehicles will **be required to have Hot Pit pass** on windshield. **No overnight camping** in the Hot Pit Area. **No minors** 14 years or younger are allowed in the Hot Pit, unless you have a driver band.
- 7. Absolutely NO alternate pitting on course, EXCEPT for the HOT PIT ONLY!
- 8. There will be two (2) Paved Road Xing's, we will NOT STOP the RACE VEHICLES, there will not be any cross traffic.
- 9. **The All Terrain Concepts UTV Legends Championship** is a <u>NO</u> pre-run race. Any entry caught riding in the course area after September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 will be subject to possible disqualification from the race
- 10. You MUST have a PIT PASS to get in to the Main Parking Area. Limit (5) Pit Passes per entry.
- 11. We have done a lot of work to get all of the permits for **the All Terrain Concepts UTV Legends Championship**, please follow the rules!
- 12. You may ride your race Motorcycle, Quad or UTV in the **Tropicana Laughlin** parking lot to the Tech & Contingency area. **However, UTV's,** even with a license plate, are no longer allowed to drive on the streets in Nevada. **DO NOT** drive your UTV's on the streets, you will receive a ticket. Again, you will **only be allowed** to ride your MC, Quad & UTV's on the **designated route. Please watch your speed! See Transfer map**
- 13. You must park in the pit area as shown on the map. Overnight Camping is **not** allowed at the Hot Pit.
- 14. **DO NOT CUT ANY WOOD; BRING YOUR OWN! PLEASE NO WOOD WITH NAILS** (i.e., No Pallets!) It maybe YOU that drives over a nail and gets a flat! THINK!!
- 15. The starting order **will be announced** on the **MANDATORY RIDERS/DRIVERS MEETING** held in the Tropicana Laughlin Theater Pavilion on Friday, September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
- 16. The **2021 All Terrain Concepts UTV Legends Championship** course is high speed area, with sand washes, a few rocky areas and some jumps.
- 17. The **BLM** and **BEST IN THE DESERT** officials will be on the course **watching** for **short cutting**. If we catch you **short cutting** you **will be disqualified** from the race, **you must stay on the course! Please!!** The only time you should leave the exact marked course is to pass someone in the event of a mechanical issue. Stay on the course.
- 18. Support Crews!! If you hear your race vehicle is broken down DO NOT JUMP in your truck and try to go out on the course to help them. First, get in contact with the Pit Captain at one of the 2 (two) pits. Or, contact RUGGED RELAY at 151.490 for further information and direction from BITD officials.
- 19. The race course markings area as follows:
  - White Mile Markers with a Pink Directional Arrow every mile.
  - Pink Ribbon and Pink Directional Arrows as needed for general course direction.
  - High Speed Turns;
    - 2 sets of Bright Yellow Turn Ahead Signs with Yellow Arrows in advance as needed.
    - Pink Directional Arrow with a Green Turn Indication Arrow "ON THE ACTUAL TURN",
  - > Bright Orange Danger Sign(s) on actual danger, number of Dangers indicate severity.
  - High Speed Danger
    - 2 sets of Orange Danger Ahead Sign(s) in advance as need
    - Bright Orange Danger Sign(s) on actual danger, number of Dangers indicate severity.
  - > Yellow Caution Tape for areas not to go, or to mark something not to hit.
  - White with Black "W" Wrong indicators to shown road, trail, wash not to travel down.
  - > Bright Orange "DQ" signs. Areas we have been asked to NOT USE at all costs.



- 20. The course mileage is approximately a 17-mile Loop for Desert and 7-mile loop for Short Course
- 21. The 2021 All Terrain Concepts UTV Legends Championship WILL be as follows: (see schedule for times)

Friday: (Infield Course)

 1st Race
 Youth 170 Prod, 170 Mod & 250 Mod (3 Mile Course)
 35 min + 1 Lap

 2nd Race:
 Youth 570 stock, 570 Mod & 800
 35 min + 1 Lap

 3rd Race:
 Youth RS1 & 1000
 35 min + 1 Lap

Saturday: (17 Mile Course)

1st Race: All Motorcycle & Quads 10 Laps (5) Lap min Pro Ex 170 Miles

(4) Lap Min Am

2nd Race:UTV Rally, Full Stock Turbo/NA, Sportsman6 Laps (4) lap min102 Miles3rd Race:UTV Pro NA, Unlimited, RS18 Laps (4) Lap min136 Miles4th RaceUTV Pro Turbo, Open8 Laps (4) Lap min136 Miles

\*\*Racers must complete minimum number of laps to be considered a finisher. \*\*

Sunday: (7 Mile Course)

1st Race: UTV Short Course 700, 800, 900, 1000 & Turbo 10 Laps (7) Lap Min (1000 & Turbo) 70 miles

(5) Lap Min (700, 800 & 900)

You must receive checkered flag after the overall leader to be considered a finisher.

- 22. Teams may switch riders/drivers at the Hot-Pit only.
- 23. Motorcycle/Quads/UTVs will have Dead engine start. Exception of Youth races.
- 24. Hot Pit MANDATORY STOP 25 MPH NO PASSING!!! No passing in the Hot Pit! GO SLOW!

#### **Special Notes:**

- 1. Race area elevation, 558 feet.
- 2. Gear for a faster racecourse.
- **3.** Please register as early at your designated time, see schedule of events.
- 4. Bring lock and chain to LOCK UP your Motorcycle, Quad or UTV. LOCK UP your gear.
- 5. MANDATORY You must have a fire extinguisher in the Hot Pit Area. (1-10 lb. minimum as per BITD General Rules)
- 6. Mandatory that all pits must have some form of approved fuel containment mat under the vehicle when fueling. Must have a bucket (preferably metal bucket) to keep over flowing fuel from reaching the ground.

# What to bring to rider registration and technical inspection.

### Rider registration is the first thing you do! Read the schedule of events.

- 1. Driver/Rider must pick up their own armband at Registration
- 2. Be sure to take your helmet, vehicle and UTV's will need to bring fire suits to Technical Inspection!
- 3. Motorcycle Classes 30, 40, and 50 must have proof of age.
- 4. Have correct numbers and background color on number plates.
  - \*\*It is critical for proper scoring that you have the proper numbers with readable plates. You will be asked to turn around and get the proper number plates if our tech inspectors deem them unreadable.\*\*
- 5. ALL MC & Quad Class Champions who won the # 1 Plate in their class, can run RED BACKGROUNDS with WHITE NUMBERS, 33designating that they are the Class Champion! (i.e., N1 #301 #501 #601.) Congratulations Class Champs!!!
- 6. All other MC/Quad **Pros** must have **blue** number plates with **white** numbers and letters
- 7. All other MC/Quad Experts must have white number plates with black numbers.
- 8. All MC/Quad Amateurs must have yellow number plates with black numbers
- 9. Motorcycles must have three (3) sets of numbers and plates
- 10. Quads must have two (2) sets, front & back. We suggest "fish tail" style plates" if your quad can accommodate them, they ARE NOT MANDATORY.
- 11. You must have a Transponder for scoring; they are \$100 and yours to keep, good for 2-years!

Finally, please read through all of the items in the "FINAL INFORMATION PACKET"! All of this may seem overwhelming, however "EVERYTHING IS IMPORTANT"! Please read again if you are not absolutely sure what to do. With the BLM, The City of Laughlin, Clark County & the State of Nevada will be watching us closely, it is very important you follow all rules and not be "that person" who makes it difficult for the rest of us to continue racing in Parker!

Keep in mind, BEST IN THE DESERT does not care - What your name is - Who your sponsor is or How much money you have! Our goals are simple, BE FAIR TO ALL ENTRANTS, OFFER A SAFE RACE, and most important, DO OUR VERY BEST TO MAKE THIS A FUN WEEKEND!
