

BEST IN THE DESERT RACING ASSOCIATION

Car/Truck, Motorcycle, Quad & UTV Rookie of the Year Criteria

1. If you have **NEVER** been Driver/Rider of Record in Best In The Desert you are eligible for the Rookie of the Year. There will be three (3) separate Rookies this year, one for Car/Truck, one for UTV's and one for Motorcycle/Quads.
2. If you **HAVE BEEN** Driver/Rider of Record in Best In The Desert you may compete for Rookie of the Year points if you have only raced a total of two (2) events during 2018, 2019 or 2020 as Driver/Rider of Record.

Example #1: One race in 2018, 2019, 2020.
Example #2: Two races in 2019
Example #3: Two races in 2020
3. However, if you have one (1) class win with Best In The Desert as Driver of Record the win disqualifies you for Rookie of the Year points in 2021.
4. Driver/Rider of Record Car/Truck/MC/Quad (Rookie) must enter ALL RACES in the 2021 "The American Off-Road Racing Series." For Car/Trucks that is: Parker 425, Silver State 300, Vegas to Reno, Laughlin Desert Classic, and the Blue Water Desert Challenge. For UTV/MC/Quad that is: Parker 250, UTV Legends Championship, Silver State 300, Vegas to Reno, and the Blue Water Desert Challenge. This excludes the World Hare & Hound Race, points collected from this race will not be counted towards Rookie of the Year points.
5. The driver going for Rookie must get in/on the race vehicle and drive during all races, he doesn't have to start or finish but he does need to get in and drive the vehicle at some time during the race.
6. **Rookie of the Year** is based on total number of class points earned for the total year. There are NO throw out races for the Rookie.
7. **Rookie of the Year** will receive a special, one of a kind "Rookie of the Year" sweatshirt at the Year-End Awards and a Best In The Desert Rookie of the Year trophy. For one (1) driver of record, one rookie, not two.
7. If you think you may meet the criteria for **Rookie of the Year** you **must email** the Best In The Desert office at bitd@bitd.com, or call 702-457-5775. You must let BITD know you want to enter for Rookie of the Year before the World Hare & Hound Race, May 22nd.
