2022 SILVER STATE 300

Danger Locations

- Mile 0 to mile 300 extreme danger
- Cows, deer, elk, horses – the whole race course. BE CAREFUL, DO NOT HIT, you will be billed.
- **Cow Hot Spots-**
 - Mile 36 to 76
 - Mile 217 to 300 at finish
 - These are the heaviest locations, but they could be in all area
- Mile 12.1 – Big Rollers
- Mile 17.8 Go to right around corral
- Mile 24.4 Cattle Guard
- Mile 25.5 Cattle Guard with sharp right turn
- Mile 33.5 Turn to left around corral, DO NOT GO THRU, this is s a DQ zone
- Mile 42 to gate at 45 – this is the bad silt area. Use caution when passing, there are large ditches to the right and left. The course has NO dangers I have marked the ditches on the sides for safe passing.
- Mile 48.2 – 3 big rollers
- Mile 112.2 to 112.5 pole line road, POLES on ROAD
- Mile 114.4 – Extreme right turn down a hill. USE CAUTION
- Mile 142 to bottom of hill, steep hill, sharp curves, big banks on each side.
- Mile 143.9 – Private ranches with fencing. Beware
- Mile 180.1 In thick trees, Sharp right turn through gate.
- Mile 180.6 Through gate, do not run out onto rail road tracks.
- Mile 184.5 – Old rail road bridge
- Mile 114.7 DO NOT HIT FENCE ON RIGHT
- Mile 285.6 BIG ROCK ON RIGHT
