

Time Trials “Rules Addendum”

As you are well aware this year’s Vegas to Reno time trials will be broadcast live. Therefore, we will be running a very tight ship in order to ensure the best possible television experience. Best In The Desert has gone through a great deal of expense, time and effort to make this possible. Please see the rules below and understand the importance of following the rules due to the nature of television broadcast necessities.

- Please be on time for your vehicle staging
- Please follow the guidance of the staging staff
- You will be allowed (1) site lap of the time trial course
- When you cross the finish line on your sight lap, please do not go over **30 MPH**
 - This is the final verification that your transponder is working properly
- You are **not allowed** to stop during your site lap
- You must average a minimum of **30 MPH** during your site lap
- If your vehicle has a mechanical problem, either during your site lap or— during your qualifying lap, please pull your vehicle completely off of the course to allow the next vehicle to pass

Special Rules For 2022

1. Jumping the Start Line – if a race vehicle leaves the start line before the green light goes on, that race vehicle will receive a 3-minute time penalty to be added to the race vehicles qualifying time.
2. If any race vehicle maliciously makes contact with another race vehicle, the race vehicle with malicious intent will receive a 1-hour penalty to be added to the race vehicles race day finish results. Race directors will determine the definition of malicious intent on a case-by-case basis or as needed.
3. If any race vehicles qualifying run is maliciously obstructed by another race vehicle, the race vehicle that has been interfered with will receive another qualifying lap, solo, at the conclusion of the race vehicles perspective group or when the race vehicle is able to do so.
4. If any race vehicles qualifying run is obstructed by another vehicle, i.e., roll over, the race vehicle that has been obstructed will receive another qualifying lap, solo, at the conclusion of the race vehicles perspective group. Race directors will determine if obstruction qualifies as an event worthy of a second run for the obstructed race vehicle.
5. All race vehicles must average a minimum of 30 MPH on site lap. Traveling a faster pace is allowed. Race vehicles that travel a faster pace, please be courteous to those vehicles ahead of you. Rule 2 also applies to site laps.
