****REGISTRATION-EVENT EXPO-TECH INSPECTION-CONTINGENCY**

1ST - <u>Check in at registration at the Registration Booth</u>

- 1. Your first step at online and on-site registration check-in will be to locate the check-in table.
- 2. You will go to the appropriate line after receiving your packet.
 - 1) Unpaid Balances:
 - If you have unpaid balances, you will come to this line first!
 - A) Complete Online Registrations = Priority Line:
 - If you have registered online before the Friday, April 19th cutoff date.
 - paid in full
 - have no changes to your entry
 - have properly collected all signatures of racers/drivers for your vehicle
 - Racer Liability Forms can be signed here
 - RACER LIABILITY FORM
 - have properly collected signatures from everyone in your pits with you during this event

 <u>PIT CREW LIABILITY WAIVER</u>
 - B) Changes to Online Registrations = Regular Line: If you have any of the following or have not registered yet
 - Driver additions/changes
 - Sponsor Changes
 - Vehicle Number Corrections
 - Liability Waivers not fully signed
 - Pit Crew Passes not fully signed
 - Memberships not Paid

2^{nd} – Event Expo and Technical Inspection in the Southwest Parking Lot of the Las Vegas Motor Speedway

At least one (1) of the entrants listed on the official **BITD SS300** entry form, with **BITD** Official armband, must be with the race vehicle through Technical Inspection. During Tech Inspection, there will be a designated off-load section of the parking lot where you will need to off-load your racing vehicle. You must drive your Car/Truck/UTV/MC/Quad from off-load to Tech Inspection and Contingency.

${m \mathcal{3}}^{rd}$ - Go to the Racing Trax Booth set-up within Event Expo to pick up your tracking unit

Racing Trax units will be required for all Vehicles at this event. Same day, on-site, the registration late fee is \$25. This tracking unit is separate from your transponder. THIS IS FOR YOUR SAFETY, NOT FOR YOUR SCORE. You will pick up the unit on-site, and our Racing Trax team will install it at the Tech & Event Expo. If you need a bracket, please order it today and have it installed before the event.

4th–<u>Watch the Drivers Meeting posted online at BITD.COM</u>

We pull **25 random names & vehicle numbers**; there must be at least one racer from your team who watched the video. A one-hour (1-hour) time penalty will be issued to your team if your number is called from the random list and you do not confirm attendance.



Special Notes & Rules for SS300

- 1. The SS300 is a no-pre-run race after the designated April 6th—7th Pre-Run. Any entry caught riding in the course area will be subject to possible disqualification from the race.
- 2. BITD is again using RUGGED RELAY race communications. Radio relays provide critical communication between race operations, teams, and riders for improved safety and track operations. Use frequency <u>151.490</u> for Radio Communications for 2024!!!
- 3. BITD will provide Pit Service at Pit 3 & Pit 5. You MUST bring your gas can and gas. Register on bitd.com!
 - a. Pit 3
 - i. We will set up a pit with the tools needed to fix your vehicle. No parts will be provided. They will be held there if you want to bring spare parts. This pit will also be used as a fuel Pit.
 - 1. We have a Fuel Mat & our team has the full Fuel Suit if you'd like us to help fuel
 - ii. You will need to provide your dump cans & fuel
 - 1. These need to be brought to Tech on Friday
 - b. Pit 5
 - i. This pit will be a fuel only Pit
 - 1. We have Fuel Mats & our team has the full Fuel Suit if you'd like us to help fuel
 - ii. You will need to provide your own fuel cans and dump tanks
 - 1. These need to be brought to Tech on Friday
- 4. Your pit crews DO NOT need a 4WD vehicle to get in or out of the Five (5) Pits. Please clean your pit area before you leave each Pit Stop. As the diagrams show, you must park at the Pit Stops; refer to your Pit book for directions! Absolutely no pitting anywhere else on the course except at the BITD OFFICIAL Pit Stops. No outside assistance is allowed on the race course.
- 5. While Vehicle Pit Passes are not required for the Main Pit, Pit Crew Members must fill out the Pit Crew Liability Form by clicking here: <u>PIT CREW LIABILITY WAIVER</u>. Pit Crew members will receive their Pit Entry wristbands after signing the liability forms. Wristbands will be given after waivers are signed at registration. Entry into the pits will require a wristband.
 - a. **Special Note:** While Vehicle Pit Passes are not required at this race, All SUPPORT VEHICLES must have the number of the Race Vehicle they support on the right side of the windshield and the rear window. **Please use six (6) inch numbers.**
- 6. Tell your support crews not to speed on highways or county roads going in or out of the pit areas. Please be safe! The BLM Rangers, NV Highway Patrol, and Local Sheriff will be in force.
- 7. Support Crews!! If you hear your race vehicle is broken down, DO NOT JUMP in your truck and try to go out on the course to help them. First, contact the Pit Captain at any Five (5) pits. Or, contact BITD Comm at 151.490 for further information and direction from BITD officials.
- 8. Tell your support vehicle NOT TO STOP at any racecourse Paved Road crossing to spectate. NO PARKING!!!
- 9. NO SUPPORT TRUCKS OR CHASE VEHICLES WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE RACE COURSE DURING THE RACE.
- 10. Five (5) PRCs will be throughout the Race. It will be <u>MANDATORY</u> for <u>EVERY RACE VEHICLE</u> to come to a <u>COMPLETE STOP</u>! You must <u>WAIT FOR THE GREEN "GO" SIGN TO BE SHOWN</u> before you cross the paved road! Because of NDOT regulations, it is imperative that you stop and do not accelerate until you pass the green signs that say "Resume Race Speed." DO NOT throw rocks on the highway with your race vehicle; AUTOMATIC PENALTY IF YOU DO! As you approach, there will be signs indicating 25mph, a STOP sign on the road, and a stop sign in the PRC Captain's hand. You must wait until the PRC flagman indicates that you can go by showing the "GO" sign. DO NOT GO ON YOUR OWN. The PRC flagman will try not to stop you for an extended time. Please tell your pit crews, "DO NOT STOP or SLOW DOWN at the PRC LOCATIONS." Your time at the PRC depends on the traffic volume; you will not be awarded time for the time stopped.
- 11. Do not short course!! Please stay on the course except to pass another vehicle! Please do not take shortcuts! All checkpoints in SS300 are hidden checks. DON'T TAKE shortcuts!
- 12. If your race vehicle is broken down and you cannot fix it yourself, then MC/Q USE YOUR STUCK STUB.
 Cars/Trucks/UTVs use the Racing Trax to push the mechanical button. BITD will try to help you. Please don't give up; we have retrievable vehicles to help you; finishing is your goal!
- 13. Ride and Drive Safe!! Do not go backward on the course!! No matter what happens!! Think at all times!!
- 14. If you are interested in having a Helicopter or Drone fly for you, you will need to have the Pilot fill out the form found on the Race Info tab on bitd.com. This form MUST be filled out before April 17th and emailed to <u>bitd@bitd.com</u>. This is non-negotiable.
- **15.** There will be mile markers every mile on the course, starting at Mile 1 and ending at Mile 262. The mile markers are white/black.
- 16. The race course markings are as follows:
 - > White Mile Markers with a Pink Directional Arrow every mile.
 - > Pink Ribbon and Pink Directional Arrows as needed for general course direction.
 - High-Speed Turns:
 - 2 sets of Bright Yellow Turn Ahead Signs with Yellow Arrows in advance as needed.
 - Pink Directional Arrow with a Green Turn Indication Arrow "ON THE ACTUAL TURN,"
 - **>** Bright Orange Danger Sign(s) on actual danger; the number of Dangers indicates severity.



- High-Speed Danger:
 - 2 sets of Orange Danger Ahead Sign(s) in advance as need
 - Bright Orange Danger Sign(s) on actual danger; number of Dangers indicates severity.
- > Yellow Caution Tape for areas not to go or to mark something not to hit.
- > White with Black "W" Wrong indicators to show road, trail, and wash not to travel down.
- > Bright Orange "DQ" signs. Areas we have been asked to NOT USE at all costs.
- 17. <u>Transponders</u> are mandatory for scoring. They cost \$100 if you do not have one or need to purchase a new one. We will verify your transponder's work as you go through the timing loop at Registration. If you have purchased a TX, you must pick it up from Tech!

18. The course mileage is approximately 262 Miles Long.

19. It is mandatory that all pits must have some form of approved fuel containment mat under your vehicle when fueling. A bucket (preferably metal) must be required to prevent overflowing fuel from reaching the ground—mandatory 10 lb. Fire Extinguisher in all Pits.

What to bring to rider registration and technical inspection.

Rider registration is the first thing you do! Read the schedule of events.

- 1. Pit Crew Waivers are available online and **MUST** be filled out before Registration to pick up your passes. This link can be found on bitd.com or listed above.
- 2. Racer Liability Waivers are available online and **MUST** be filled out before Registration to pick up your passes. This link can be found on bitd.com or listed above.
- 3. Be sure to take your helmet & vehicle; UTVs must bring fire suits to Tech Inspection!
- 4. Have correct numbers and background color on number plates.
 - a. For proper scoring, you must have the proper numbers with readable plates. You will be asked to turn around and get the proper number plates, as our tech inspectors deem them unreadable.
- 5. We will have numbers available for purchase on-site. You must purchase new numbers if you do not have the correct number on your number plates. THIS IS FOR YOU!
- 6. ALL MC & Quad Class Champions who won the # 1 Plate in their class can run RED BACKGROUNDS with WHITE NUMBERS, designating that they are the Class Champion! (i.e., N1–#301–#501–#601.) Congratulations, Class Champs!!!
- 7. You **must** have a Transponder for scoring; they are \$100 and yours to keep.

Finally, please read through the "FINAL INFORMATION PACKET" items! This may seem overwhelming; however, "EVERYTHING IS IMPORTANT"! Please read again if you are not sure what to do. The world is watching this race closely, so it is very important that you follow all the rules and not be "that person" who makes it difficult for the rest of us to continue racing. Period.

Remember, **BITD** does not care what your name is, who your sponsor is, or how much money you have!

Our goals are simple: BE FAIR TO ALL ENTRANTS, OFFER A SAFE RACE, and, most importantly, **DO OUR** VERY BEST TO MAKE THIS A FUN WEEKEND!
